for this hero who gave up so much for his country."

Sergeant Kalish and his dog Fynn were trained to detect IEDs (improvised explosive devices) or "road-side" bombs. He only had 30 days left on his tour of duty when he stepped on an IED and was severely injured.

SouthStar Communities provided a one-acre homesite for Kalish in its Lake Ridge community on Joe Pool Lake. The homesite features a beautiful view of the lake and is located inside one of the community's gated neighborhoods.

"We are proud to welcome Sgt. Kalish and Fynn to our Lake Ridge community. Our residents have strongly supported this project and are looking forward to having an American hero as their new neighbor," said Thad Rutherford, COO of SouthStar Communities. "This project could not have happened without the community-wide support of so many volunteers and businesses, and we are thrilled to have been a part of it."

Sgt. Kalish received a hero's welcome with neighbors, contractors, sponsors and organizations on hand to show their support. Several former NFL players also were in attendance.

Operation FINALLY HOME builds homes for veterans who are 90-100% disabled but want to get their lives back on track. The non-profit has built more than 50 homes for veterans in Texas to date and relies on the donations of developers, homebuilders, contractors, corporate sponsors and individual contributors to continue building homes

for those who have given so much for our country.

Victory Custom Homes, co-founded by former Dallas Cowboys player Bill Bates and Alan Dulworth, built the home.

"It was an honor to be able to build this home for Kenny, who has sacrificed so much for our country," said Bill Bates, Victory Custom Homes partner and Super Bowl Champion. "So many companies and organizations donated their services to make this happen, and the finished product is truly a beautiful home that we hope Kenny will enjoy for many years to come."

The 2,500-square-foot, custombuilt home features four bedrooms, three baths, a formal dining room, granite countertops and wood floors throughout. The home was built with custom accessories for Kalish including pull-down shelving and a wide master shower. Fynn also has plenty of room to run in the large, fenced backyard.

The home will be the first time

Kalish has lived alone and he said he is looking forward to the peace and quiet.

"This is the beginning of a new life for me and I can't thank everyone enough," Kalish said. "Where my new home is - it's truly a sanctuary with the view, the quietness and the peace. I think I'm most excited about the open floor plan, which is going to allow me to move around easier, especially the wide doors in the bathroom. It all just means so much to me."

# Four For Fall

The heat slowly fades, the leaves are set to turn their multiple hues, tailgaters are prepping for their weekly football festivals and government issues are popping up like a whack a mole game at a Halloween festival. Welcome to Fall in an election year.

While the regulatory environment we face is never all doom and gloom, the looming time table is a mixed bag. First, the Tricks.

1. The timeline for the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) opportunity to have an impact via its proposed, and much needed, amending of the Lead: Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) rule is facing delay. This summer, the White House Office of Management and Budget (OMB) informed the EPA that the proposed rule must be submitted to OMB for review under Executive Order 12866. Meaning months could be added to the process before a decision can be made.

The RRP rule changes would remove the hands-on training requirement for all certified renovators to keep their EPA certification up to date by allowing the option to complete the refresher training course online. The rule change only applies to those seeking recertification. Newly certified contractors would still be required to complete hands-on training.

EPA submitted the rule change to OMB on Sept. 17. OMB has up to 90 days from that date to complete review. However, as thousands of certified renovators need to re-certify by July 1, 2015, it is crucial that the office finish its part before then and allow time for the EPA to complete its process and implement the changes.

2. The United States Department of Labor has awarded over \$10 million to be shared by Texas, and 18 other states, for the use of implementing or improving worker misclassification detection and enforcement initiatives.

The purpose is to increase the ability of states to "identify instances where employers improperly classify employees as independent contractors or fail to report wages paid to workers at all." To entice states to detect more incidents of worker misclassification, a "high performance bonus" program will offer \$2 million in additional grant funds to be shared by four states considered to have high performance or most improved performance in detection. The remaining \$8,225,183 is distrib-



uted among 19 states through competitive grants. Now for the Treats. After feeling the pressure of exceeding government regulation and misdirection breathing down the back of your neck like a Boris Karloff character on steroids, now you get to do something about it.

3. On November 4, you get to join the rest of Texas' voting public and make your voice heard by voting for county, state and federal officials who stand against overbearing government regulation and for a growing Texas economy In addition, you get to cast a vote for much needed funding to the Lone Star State's infrastructure.

A key measure on the ballot will be Proposition 1. The proposed amendment would authorize annual disbursements from the state's oil and gas production tax collections to the State Highway Fund. The most current official estimate of how much this would be is \$1.4 billion for 2014.

The amendment specifies that the money could not be used for toll road projects. Dallas Builders Association and the Texas Association of Builders were advocates for the amendment's enabling legislation in the last session.


To just keep urban road congestion at current level, repair rural roads, and maintain the state's 80,000-mile road system, TxDOT needs about \$5 billion more a year than it has now. While Proposition 1 fills just part of the need, it is a good start.

The Dallas BA will update members as we get closer to election day; but you must be registered.

4. A very effective way to help make our industry's voice heard in the halls of government is to invest in HOMEPAC of Greater Dallas. This allows us to support those who support a regulatory environment that is friendly to home building. To find out more, contact the Director of Government Affairs at david.lehde@dallasbuilders.org. Remember, if our industry does not have a seat at the table, we'll be on the menu.

Advocacy is huge part of what we do here at the Dallas Builders Association. To continue the influence we have in the community, member participation is crucial.


