## McSAM Awards entry deadline is March 27 People's Choice – March 20

Entry applications and materials will be due March 27 for the 2015 McSam Awards presented by Shoot2Sell Photography. The awards gala will be held on Thursday, May 7, at the Hotel InterContinental Crystal Ballroom. The official call for entries is available at McSAMAwards. com.

Please note that two of the categories— People's Choice Builder of the Year, Category 50;

and People's Choice Community of the Year (for developers), Category 51—are due March 20.

These customer satisfaction awards are determined by an online survey of homeowners/community residents conducted by Market Research Answers, a top consumer research firm. All other Mc-SAM categories are judged by a panel of industry experts from around the country.

To submit a People's Choice entry, members will need to provide an accurate email list of home buyers/residents from 2014 and submit it directly to the research

company. Confidentiality is strictly enforced. A minimum of 6-8 entries in each People's Choice category must be received to conduct the survey and determine a valid winner. The entry deadline is earlier than the rest of the McSAM categories because the category requires a 3-4 week research process.

This year's Mc-SAM Awards has many new and exciting aspects. A team of builder

leadership was invited to serve on the program's advisory committee and review all categories, requirements, partnerships and the overall event. The group shared ideas and suggestions that became the guidelines for this year's McSAM Awards program.

Thoughtful consideration was given to categories to recognize the current product within the marketplace, while allowing for expansion of categories by the judges should entries suggest. 





#### **Association Advocacy Seeks to Protect Builders** and Property Owners from the Regulatory Wolf

A Dallas Builders Association driven initiative has resulted in a Texas Association of Builders (TAB) priority bill being filed relating to building energy efficiency performance standards. With the stringency of energy codes increasing at too fast a rate, and the inflexibility of the process matching pace, the negative impact on housing affordability is now a major concern. Many builders are faced with the challenge of getting an accurate value for energy efficient features in the appraisal process.

One solution to this problem has come in the form of a bill filed by Representative Jason Villalba of Dallas. H.B. 1736 slows the current breakneck pace of energy codes adoption by limiting the cycle the State Energy Conservation Office can adopt a new edition to once every six years. In addition to a longer code review cycle, the bill also allows for a more sensible energy code performance path and gives builders more options.

And equally important, H.B. 1736 creates a Building Energy Efficiency Advisory Committee, allowing for needed guidance from stakeholders. The 13-member committee would include two commercial builders and two residential builders who are members of a statewide trade association.

Another TAB priority bill that protect builders from bogus law suits has been filed by Representative Phil King of Weatherford. The Texas Uniform Condominium Act (H.B. 1455) makes needed changes to the procedures required for a condominium association to file suit or initiate arbitration related to defect or design. The bill does not prevent legitimate claims on construction defects, rather it closes a loophole that has been exploited by associations to file a claim without seeking approval from the condo unit owners. Along with the requirement that approval be obtained from condo unit owners holding at least 67 percent of the total votes in a condo association, H.B. 1455 also requires an independent inspection and report from a third-party licensed professional engineer. The report would not only include descriptions of the present physical condition of the units in question, but also any modifications, maintenance or repairs to the units or common elements performed by the unit owners or the association. And the report would have to be prepared by a person who is not employed by or otherwise affiliated with the attorney or law firm that represents or will represent the association in the claim.

It is important to note that H.B. 1455 protects not only builders, but also the condo unit owner. The requirement for notification to and approval by condo unit owners prior to filing a claim helps ensure that those owners have been adequately informed of how such an action will affect their private property rights, as well as the limitations a claim could put on the resale or refinancing of their unit due to what would be otherwise unknown cases involving their property. H.B. 1455 prevents lawsuit abuse against condo unit owners and builders.

At the federal level, the assault on property owners from agencies and the administration continues. Executive Order (EO) 13690, signed by President Obama on Jan 30, could limit how and where members develop, build and remodel in areas near coasts and rivers. The 2015 EO updates a 1977 EO that required federal agencies to take actions

to preserve the nation's floodplains and limit development of these areas. While the Administration has stated that EO 13690 is targeted to federally approved or funded projects, there is concern that the reach of 13690 could be broader and even affect permitting for projects that are privately funded. Members who are familiar with the proposed Waters of the United States definitions, as well as the concerns regarding habitat listings in the Endangered Species Act, will understand why NAHB and the Dallas Builders Association have these concerns

Strict interpretation of EO 13690 implies that projects financed and approved by the federal government would be included. This means it could relate to FHA and HUD housing programs, as well as the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The Federal Emergency Management Agency uses the 100 year floodplain definition for mapping the entire country and the NFIP bases their rules on FEMA's designation. Currently, it is unclear how the new federal standard under EO 13690 will impact FEMA's mapping.

Bringing further concern is that building codes and zoning requirements are mostly developed by state and local governments, which raises the question of whether conflict could arise between new federal requirements and locally existing regulations.

EO 13690 is just the latest hit in a long list of federal overreaches.

NAHB and the Dallas BA will continue to communicate our concerns to our U.S. Congressional delegation.



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
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
