

GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

A core mission of the Dallas Builders Association is advocacy. Representing the home building industry in city halls, county courthouses, the state Capitol and area congressional offices, Dallas BA works to keep its members informed on regulatory issues as well as serving as a trusted information resource for public officials. Successes have included code changes, favorable local tax structure, more efficient permitting processes and protection from harmful ordinances and regulations.



DALLAS BA advocacy efforts annually save the typical home builder approximately \$7,000 per housing start.







HOMEPAC OF GREATER DALLAS

The Association's general-purpose political action committee (PAC) is devoted to a point of view, not a political party. Whether it is single-family, multifamily or remodeling construction, HOMEPAC of Greater Dallas is devoted to creating a healthy housing industry free of unnecessary government taxes, regulations and fees that add to the cost of construction. The PAC's Executive Committee members oversee fund disbursements. Contributions are made to candidates for state and local office who support our free enterprise housing position and the rights and privileges of homeownership. HOMEPAC of Greater Dallas funds are also used to support ballot initiatives that lead to efficient and orderly urban and rural growth.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The **DALLAS BA** offers dozens of educational courses and seminars, both virtually and in-person, specifically tailored for your needs as a building professional and new regulations affecting the industry.

Continuing Education Series

The education offerings at the Association range from novice to advanced learning. The National Association of Home Builders has awarded the Dallas Builders Association education program twice for the outstanding line up of classes available to members.

Each year the Dallas BA Education Committee develops a robust schedule of classes. Continuing education offerings range from building technology to business development to hands-on training. Classes are relevant to North Texas and help members better understand codes and market trends unique to the metroplex. Instructors of these classes are top industry experts, and each one is reviewed and approved by the Dallas BA Education Committee.

Certification Courses

These courses allow industry professionals to earn and maintain national and local certifications. The Dallas BA is licensed through NAHB to offer diverse courses allowing builders, trade partners and associates to gain knowledge and set themselves apart from the competition.
