

The HomeFront

Plenty To Be Aware Of

With the closing of one legislative session in Austin and more on the horizon, as well as municipal fee and code updates, there is plenty to keep the industry's attention this summer.

In May, the 87th regular session of the Texas Legislature adjourned Sine Die. Numerous bills that could impact home building were introduced and a few of the legislative successes are highlighted below.

TAB and Dallas BA priority legislation that helps give homeowners and builders more choice in energy features was recently signed into law by Governor Abbott. HB 3215, authored by Representative Charlie Geren and sponsored by Senator Brian Hughes, updates the existing performance-based avenue in the state energy code with the latest American National Standards Institute (ANSI) home energy rating system index.

This will allow homeowners and builders to choose the features best suited for them and encourage innovation in energy efficiency.

The bill provides a new optional pathway for energy code compliance via the ANSI 301 standard coupled with requirements for wall and ceiling insulation.

During the bill's journey through the legislature, Dallas BA members and staff made trips to the Capitol to offer testimony and support, as well as provide needed information during the drafting of HB 3215. The law becomes effective Sept. 1, 2021.

Legislation was passed that furthers the work done last session regarding rollback taxes on land appraised with a special use valuation, such as timber or open-space land, when the land is taken out of that usage. In the 86th session, work was done that reduced the number of years for which rollback taxes were due from five years to three. This session, HB 3833, by Rep. Phil King, reduces the excessive tax burden property owners face by eliminating the interest due on rollback

HB 3833 was signed into law by the Governor in June, effective immediately. Dallas BA membership has been helpful in the advocacy for both the legislation reducing the number of years rollback taxes are due and the elimination of interest.

In response to building inspection challenges during the pandemic and other regional disasters, SB 877 by Senator Kelly Hancock was passed and signed into law by the Governor. The law authorizes builders to use third party inspectors in an area of a munici-

pality that is subject to a declaration of disaster, granted the third party meets common criteria and is not the owner of the building or the person whose work is subject to inspection.

There were other bills that drew the attention of the home building industry, including legislation that addressed construction trades education.

Governor Abbott has called for a special session to begin on July 8 to address issues that were not completed during the regular session. It is not yet known what the legislative topics will be

On the local front, there is no summer break.

The City of Celina is currently considering changes to water, wastewater, and roadway impact fees. The issue was recently heard before the city's Planning & Zoning Committee and is currently scheduled for a hearing before the City Council on July 13.

The proposed fees listed in the impact fee studies would move wastewater impact fees (1" meter) to \$5,200, water impact fees (1" meter) to \$4,400, and roadway impact fees to \$5,500 for service areas 1-6 and \$4,400 for service area 7. Residential developments that have existing entitlements regarding impact fees through developer agreements should not be affected by the changes.

Dallas BA offered our concerns regarding the level of the fee increases in communication to the Planning & Zoning Committee on June 15. Mainly, the proposed wastewater and roadway impact fee increases, combined with the decrease in water impact fees, would result in a significant increase per home in all service areas where the fees would be applicable. Regulatory costs account for nearly a quarter of new home prices with a considerable share due to fees and regulations that are imposed during the lot's development.

A process that is important to home builders in our region is the drafting of regional code amendment recommendations via the North Central Texas Council of Government's Regional Codes Coordinating Committee (RCCC). Dallas BA is a voting member on the committee, along with

area building officials and other stakeholders.

The RCCC has been reviewing the 2021 I-Codes and Dallas BA staff and members have had success offering amendments. The goal is to develop recommendations for safe and effective building codes that better fit this region.

Most of the regional code amendments recommendations have met approval by the RCCC and are now headed to a final step with the NCT-COG board. Key to multifamily developments, Dallas BA recommended, to the RCCC Fire Advisory Board, an amendment for the International Fire Code that adjusts the allowed height of a building where NFPA 13R multifamily sprinkler systems can still be used before a full NFPA 13 system is reguired. The amendment recommendation was approved by the subcommittee and the RCCC. A pool proximity provision, drafted in effort to protect home foundations when a pool is installed by the homeowner after home construction and purchase, was also passed by the committee.

Always a point of focus is the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC). Dallas BA representatives, as well as building officials and representatives who focus on energy efficiency, have spent many hours in meetings going through the IECC looking to tailor it for the challenges faced in the DFW region, while looking to avoid as many unneeded mandates and cost increases as possible.

The IECC recommendations are still subject to final subcommittee and committee approval expected later this summer. Builders are encouraged to monitor the municipalities they build in for code adoptions.

Dallas BA will continue to monitor these and policies that impact home building. Members who have questions regarding the Association's advocacy efforts can contact the Director of Government Affairs.

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

Dallas BA rebuilding fund passes \$100K!

The rebuilding fund campaign to restore Association offices following catastrophic damage sustained during winter storms in February has surpassed \$100,000, thanks to the generous support of members and housing industry friends.

Damage was caused by significant flooding resulting from a broken fire sprinkler pipe. The entire lower floor was covered in nearly a foot of water and portions of the ceiling collapsed under the weight of onrushing water.

Much of the building's interior was either destroyed or heavily damaged. This includes files, office equipment and computers.

home and from office space in Plano donated by longtime member Burgess Construction Consultants.

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
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


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
