March 23 State of the Industry Summit will feature Johnson, Leach, Gaines

Presented in partnership with Hotchkiss Insurance Agency, the March 23 State of the Industry Summit will delve into the political and economic landscape for housing in the year ahead.

The program will begin with a discussion with Sen. Nathan Johnson (D-Dallas) and Rep. Jeff Leach (R-Plano) about the state of Texas politics, the priorities of the state legislature and discussion of issues that impact housing.

Both legislators have an excellent track record of supporting Association priorities. The discussion, facilitated by Executive Officer Phil Crone, will demonstrate that housing affordability is a bipartisan issue.

The second half of the program will feature research economist Dr. Jim Gaines from Texas A&M University's Texas Real Estate Research Center.

Dr. Gaines will dive into the supply side constraints that continue to hinder the housing industry. He will also discuss disruptions to the energy sector and overall economic impact resulting from Russia's invasion of Ukraine.



Dallas BA Advocacy Engaged on All Fronts

It has been a busy winter for the Dallas Builders Association's advocacy efforts, and it is only a precursor to what the year will bring.

In Dallas, the Association has continued to put pressure on the city to solve permitting delays and improve other areas of the development process, including the city's challenging online permitting

Making the industry's voice heard during a special called Jan. 31 meeting of City of Dallas Government Performance and Financial Management Committee. Dallas BA's Executive Officer Phil Crone was joined by several member builders in citing problems that have continued to lead to delays, including the inefficient online system and unresponsive staff. Association members gave examples of delays they have faced and how those delays result in thousands of dollars in added carrying costs and liability.

Association members also stressed the importance of filling the vacant position for Chief Building Official. The meeting also included an update from the city's Executive in Residence, Will Mundinger who has been working since late last year to seek improvements.

The attention brought to the city's permitting delays has reached beyond the committee. On Feb. 14, Mayor Eric Johnson signaled, in his words, "Enough is enough." In a letter to the City Council. Mayor Johnson recognized the appropriate action the council has taken on the matter, but feels a new approach is needed. The mayor announced the creation of the Mayor's Workgroup on Permitting to further research solutions and monitor progress.

Tackling cost issues in other parts of the service area, Dallas BA weighed in on Feb. 7 via written comments to the City of Denton's Parks, Recreation and Beautification Board. The board was presented with the proposed update to Denton's park dedication, fee-in-lieu and development fee ordinance, which has not seen a thorough amending since it's 1998 implementation.

Dallas BA voiced the industry's concern about the impact that significant increases in the fees will have on already challenging new home costs. The fees originally proposed in the first draft of the ordinance were based on zones and were, in areas that would see many of the new homes, outrageous. After hearing concerns from stakeholders, follow up drafts of the ordinance scaled those fees back dramatically. Still, the park development fee listed in the ordinance is higher than what builders report seeing in other cities.

Dallas BA also recommended amending the language to include an exception from applicability for replacement homes, as they do not increase the number of dwelling units calculated for park dedications. While the ordinance does include credit for park-like facilities in private

development, Dallas BA has requested that those credits be increased. The Association also asked for clarification regarding park development cost calculations.

At the writing of this article, the ordinance is scheduled to be presented to the City Council on March 1.

Dallas BA is always on the look out for how local government entities are embarking on code enforcement. And we remind our members to do the same. As cities look to adopt the 2021 I-codes, including the Residential Code (IRC), or the 2018 IRC, or keep the 2015 IRC, it is important to review how state law addresses what version of the IRC relates to counties.

Section 233 of the Texas Local Government Code states that homes built in the county shall, at a minimum, conform to the version of the International Residential Code published as of May 1, 2008 (2006 IRC), or the version of the International Residential Code that is applicable in the county seat of that county. If you are building in an unincorporated area of a county and you're asked to provide anything different than this, please make the Dallas BA aware of the situation.

And a reminder that as cities look at adopting updated codes, it is wise to urge them to adopt the regionally recommended amendments provided by the North Texas Council of Governments' Regional Codes Coordinating Committee.

Dallas BA also continues to monitor any municipal enforcement for product requirements. Association members may recall that during the 2019 Texas Legislative session, legislation was signed into law that, with a few specific exceptions, prohibits municipalities from directly or indirectly prohibiting or limiting the use or installation of a building product or material if the product or material has been approved for use in the last three code cycles. This ranges from wiring to

exterior materials. Builders are encouraged to contact the Association should they suspect they are facing requirements that conflict with the state law.

With redistricting resulting in new district boundaries for state representatives and senators, as well as Texas members of the U.S. House of Representatives, the primary election season has been a big one. Dallas BA staff and members visited a number of incumbents and candidates of the state and federal levels.

In recent meetings with U.S. Congressional members in the Association's service area, Dallas BA members and staff continued to raise awareness of lumber supply and costs, labor and other issues that bring major challenges to housing affordability.

Dallas BA engages in this kind of outreach because it works. After the Biden Administration doubled lumber tariffs from 8.99% to 17.99% in November of 2021, NAHB led a charge to overturn the action, including coordinating with local HBAs to urge lawmakers to weigh in. In December, a bipartisan group from Congress, including two who heard from Dallas BA, signed a joint letter expressing urgent concern to the U.S. Secretary of Commerce. That, along with other efforts led by NAHB, sent a strong message to the White House and the Commerce Department announced they were reducing the tariff to 11.64% on Jan. 31.

With upcoming municipal elections, run-off elections, the November general election and various municipalities reviewing codes and fees, Dallas BA will continue to push to have the industry's voice heard.

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
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
